Major advance in ballet


Louis XIV (1638-1715), known as Louis the Great, or the Sun King (le Roi-Soleil), began his reign at the age of four.

Ballet as court entertainment and courtier spectacle flourished to its height.

Comédie-ballet - A spoken play (comédie) with music/dance *Opéra-ballet -* with more dramatic and thematic cohesion



Jean Baptiste Lully (1632 - 1687) Composer, Dancer & Choreographer The chief master of the French Baroque style. Director of Académie Royal de Musique, including the Académie Royale de Danse.



Peirre Beauchamps (1631 - 1705) Dancer and Choreographer. Ballet's original master teacher. He Codifies the five positions of the feet and arms. Creator of Comedie Ballet genre.


1700 Choreographie, ou l'art de decrire la danse by Raoul Auger Feuillet

documented the 5 positions codified by Beauchamps.


