## Thomas, Donald Byron Hear No Evil (2010)

The author, who has written extensively on the Dealey Plaza acoustics study, takes on analysis of much of the scientific evidence in the case. He uses illustrations, tables, and graphs to explain some of the knotty problems with the expert opinions offered in the investigation.

#### Newman, John Oswald and the CIA (2008 ed.)

The best single account of Oswald and the secret world, written after exhaustive research by a former Army intelligence officer.

#### "Who Was Lee Harvey Oswald?"

This updated *Frontline* documentary provides a good review of Oswald's enigmatic life and includes on-camera interviews with many of the key players.

## JFK Revisited: Through the Looking Glass (2021)

Directed by Oliver Stone, this documentary focuses on information disclosed by previously withheld government documents during the years following the release of his movie *JFK* in 1991. The best documentary in recent years. Strongly makes the pro-conspiracy case.
