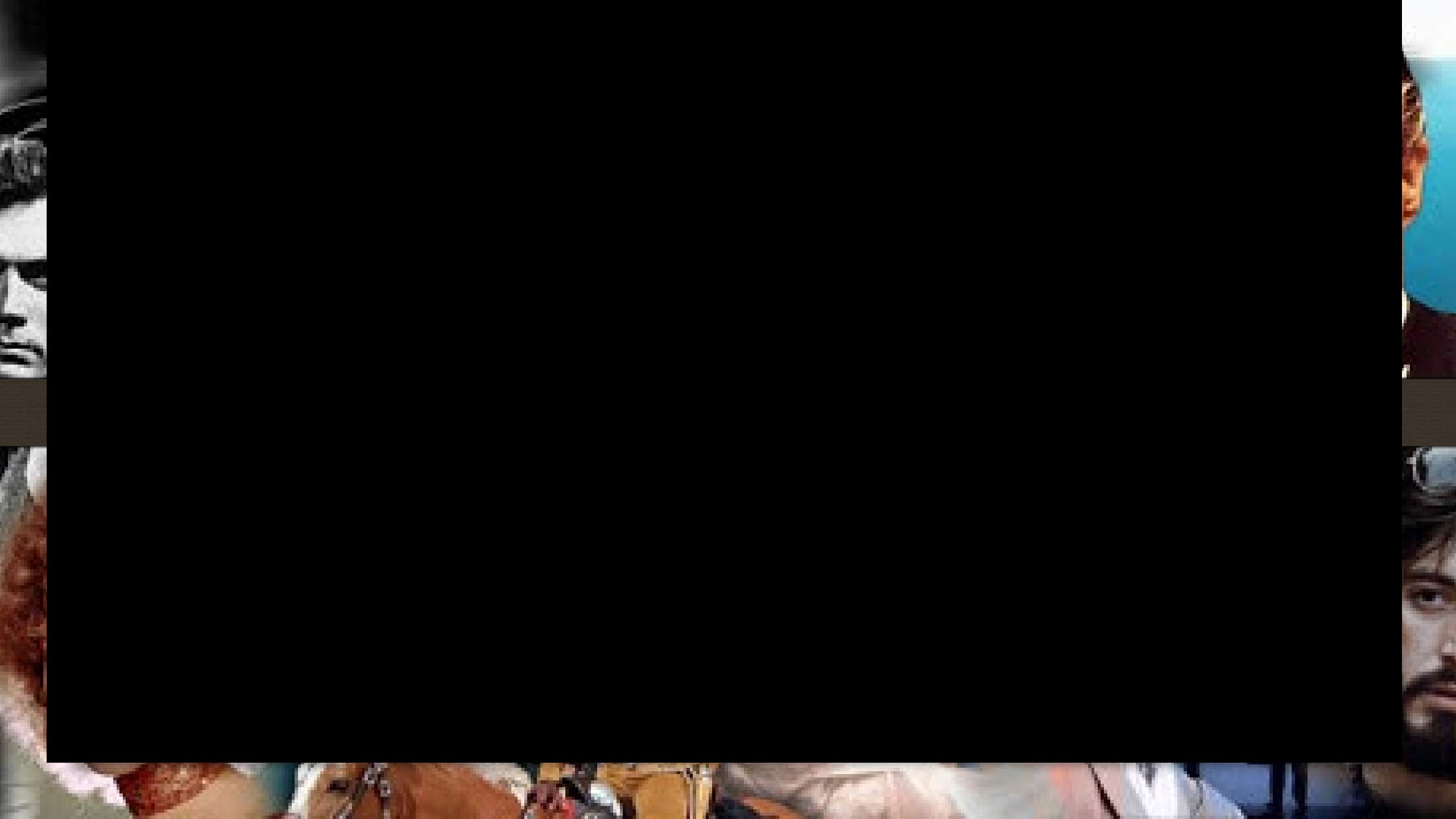

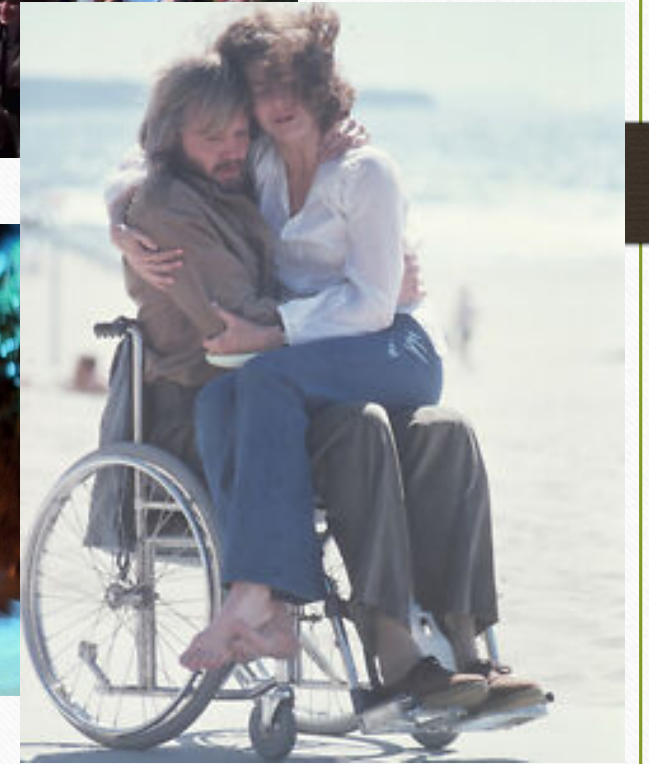

# Diversity in Studio Leadership

---

- February 2020 report on diversity among studio heads –
  - 91% are white
  - 82% are male

2015 report – 100% of studio heads were male.

# Diversity – Film Directors (2019)

---

- ✓ Women directors – 15%
- ✓ Black directors – 5%
- ✓ Asian directors – 3%
- ✓ Latino directors – 2%
- ✓ No films in 2019 were directed by Indigenous directors.

## Jack Nicholson *Batman* (1989)

---

- ✓ Agreed to reduce his up-front salary from \$10M to \$6M
- ✓ Negotiated a percentage of the film's earnings and merchandise sales, as well as a cut of the earnings from future sequels (none of which he appeared in)
- ✓ Estimated earnings - \$60M

- Most recent project – *The Irishman*
- Based on the non-fiction book *I Heard You Paint Houses*
- 10 Oscar nominations in 2020
- Limited theatrical release, followed by streaming on Netflix
- Next project - *Killers of the Flower Moon: The Osage Murders and the Birth of the FBI*
- Based on the non-fiction book by David Grann
- Starring Leonardo DiCaprio, Robert DeNiro, Jesse Plemons
- Distribution: streaming on Apple TV+





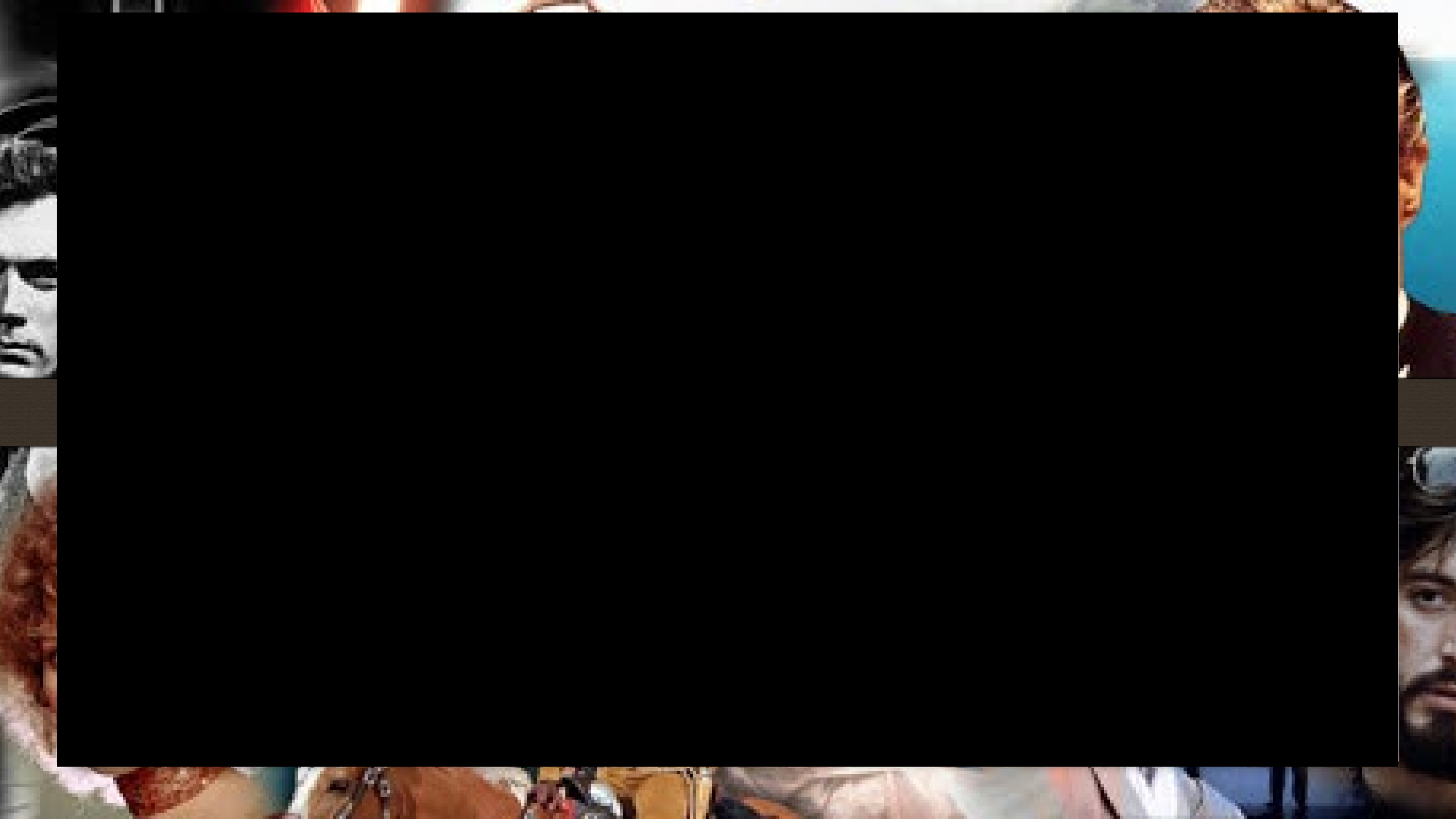
