

Art Journaling/OLLI/Patty Pyrz

Basic Supply List:

The following below is a basic supply list you'll need for the art journaling class. However, you are always encouraged to use/bring other materials in addition to this list. The brand and quality of art supplies you choose to bring is up to you. You don't have to spend a lot of money to create in an art journal!

1. A spiral-bound or composition notebook 9x12 size:

Below are two different brands on Amazon I would suggest to purchase:

**Canson Mix Media Art Book, Heavyweight French Paper, Double Sided Fine and Medium 138 Pound, 9 x 12*

**Strathmore 460-19 500 Series Visual Mixed Media Journal, Vellum, 9 x 12, White*

2. Ephemera: Old magazines (gather several for variety), old coffee table books (if they are headed to the trash otherwise...), scrapbook or patterned paper, ticket stubs, photographs, maps, old envelopes, tissue paper, etc. Gather materials you would otherwise discard or no longer use, so that you don't mind tearing them up for reuse. Preferably do not bring any types of paper that are heavy or slick (postcards, fancy brochures..etc), as these do not glue well/stick to journal paper.

3. Magazines/Catalogs: Bring a few (old or new). You can find many at the IDEA store in Urbana. These are great for finding pictures, background colors, quotes/text..etc..I will bring a few to have on-hand, if you don't have your own.

4. Paint (and different size paint brushes): Acrylic and watercolor. Bring your favorite colors. They do not need to be expensive! You can purchase various acrylic tubes and watercolor sets at Walmart/Target or search the IDEA store in Urbana. As for your brushes, make sure at least one brush is 1' wide and a few narrower ones.

5. Markers: Bring a wide variety. Fat or thin tip, sharpies, brush tip, gel pens, Crayola brand, etc...

6. Sharpened Colored pencils: Again, these don't need to be fancy! Basic Crayola will do.

7. Oil pastels: Bring your favorite colors or a set and at least one BLACK color.

8. Glue stick or Elmers Clear bottle of glue

9. One pair of scissors

10. A plastic cup to hold water (any kind will do)

11. A bag to carry all your supplies/Folder for holding your ephemera
